## *The Cervical Spine Orthopedic & Manual Therapy from a Seated Position*

Timothy O. Fearon, PT, DPT, FAAOMPT

### Course Objectives

- Develop a conceptual framework for evaluating and treating the cervical patient in the treatment-based classification system .
- Understand the evolution of TBC from the clinical perspective of common clinical syndrome recognition.
- Discuss the genuinely common clinical syndromes, the rapid recognition of them and the applicable treatments.
- Understand the application of principles for spinal mobilization on a continuum through to manipulation of the region.
- Develop manual skills in mobilization through manipulation of the thoracic & cervical spine in a seated position. A level of proficiency in the techniques will be emphasized as the class comes to conclusion.
- Understand the application of principles for therapeutic exercise augmenting manual intervention, to development of trunk control and prophylaxis in the cervical-thoracic region.
- Nurture continued development of skills with accurate and informative feedback from the 'patient' therapists with each session. Understand the experiential nature of motor skills.

### Dr. Fearon's Bio

Timothy Fearon received his PT degree from The Ohio State University. He completed the Musculoskeletal Sequence graduate program at Northwestern University. He completed his Doctorate in Physical Therapy at Northern Arizona University. While doing extensive long-term study with the Folsom Physical Therapy group he founded Phoenix Manual Therapy, which initially offered courses, based on the Nordic System of orthopedic manual therapy. Phoenix Manual Therapy progressed to offering a long-term course frame for study of the Australian approach to orthopedic manual therapy with integration of Norwegian techniques. The course has been running over the last 30 years. He earned his Full Fellowship status in the American Academy of Orthopedic Manual Therapy by the challenge process in 1999, he successfully renewed that status in 2010. He has been specializing in orthopedic manual therapy and spinal rehabilitation for the last 30 years.

Dr. Fearon has taught manual therapy courses over the last 20 years in short and long-term formats. He was lead faculty for Evidence in Motion in Fellowship Virtual Rounds, Clinical Decision Making and the Weekend Intensive courses in OMT, he continues to lead their Fellows only weekend sessions. He is adjunct faculty at A. T. Still University where he teaches manual therapy of the spine and extremities. He has been a guest instructor for multiple schools, state PT associations and the APTA.
